


Township Profile



East Norriton Township Population Growth, 1950-2000


The following report presents selected population, housing, and economic characteristics for East Norriton Township. When applicable, data for the municipalities adjacent to East Norriton (Lower Providence, the municipality of Norristown, Plymouth Township, West Norriton Township, Whitpain Township and Worcester Township, hereafter referred to as the East Norriton Subregion), and Montgomery County are included to enable comparisons with regional trends. Data were obtained from various sources but primarily consist of information collected and compiled by the U.S. Bureau of the Census. Other data sources include the Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission (DVRPC) and the Montgomery County Planning Commission.

The intent of this report is to highlight past and future growth patterns for purposes of community planning into the future.

Population


This section provides information on population in East Norriton Township, the East Norriton Subregion, and Montgomery County.

As can be seen in the chart below, the population of East Norriton Township grew from 2,987 residents in 1950 to 13,211 residents in 2000, reflecting an overall 50-year growth rate of 342%. Population in East Norriton peaked in 1990 at 13,325 then dropped very slightly to the 2000 figure of 13,211. Due to the recent increase in new housing starts, please note the population is projected to increase to 2010.

Household Composition



Overall, it should be noted that households with children account for only approximately 25% of the total households within East Norriton Township.



The composition of the resident labor force in East Norriton very closely parallels the totals for Montgomery County. The only difference is that the second and third rank occupations are reversed. However, their differences by percent are minor.


Age Cohorts East Norriton and Montgomery County, 2000

East Norriton Township and Montgomery County exhibit very similar age cohort characteristics. The age cohort 35 to 44 is virtually identical and accounts for approximately 40% of the population. The main difference is that Montgomery County has a greater percentage for the population under age 34, whereas East Norriton Township has a greater percentage over age 65.

% of acreage, Total Acres = 3,916.21


