East Norriton Township Annual Periodic Fire Safety Inspections

East Norriton Township is mandated to conduct periodic fire safety inspections of all commercial, educational, institutional, and multi-family residential buildings to ensure compliance with fire and life safety regulations. This is a program administered by the Fire Marshal's Office of East Norriton Township. The Fire Marshals are responsible for conducting these inspections of every premise located within East Norriton Township. They are required, in accordance with direction from the Township Supervisors; to assess a fee for these inspections.

Each structure is inspected and the hazards found are listed for the owner and or occupant. Also, enforcement of the fire code allows for identification of unsafe property such as open, vacant structures, which are a danger to the community and firefighters. Several items, which are of primary importance to life safety, are fire alarm systems, fire sprinkler systems, exit doors, emergency lighting, exit signs, and other fire extinguishing systems.

The following is a list of the frequency of these inspections that will occur in East Norriton Township:
