

ORDINANCE NO. 108

EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 86 DEALING WITH DOG CONTROL AND ORDINANCE NO. 69 DEALING WITH SNOW EMERGENCIES BY PROVIDING A METHOD UNDER WHICH VIOLATORS OF THE TERMS OF THESE ORDINANCES MAY VOLUNTARILY PAY A FINE AND AVOID PROSECUTION.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 86 is amended by adding thereto a new Section 3. A. which shall read as follows:

Section 3. A. In all cases where a police officer of East Norriton Township shall first give notice of the offense to the owner of the dog in question on a form noting the time and place of the offense and the nature of the offense charged; no prosecution shall be instituted for seventy-two (72) hours thereafter, provided that, if during the said seventy-two (72) hour period, the offender shall voluntarily appear at the office of the Township Secretary of East Norriton Township during regular business hours and voluntarily enter a plea of guilty and pay a fine of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) to the Township, no prosecution for such offense shall thereafter be brought.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 69 is amended by adding thereto a new Section XVI. A. to read as follows:

Section XVI. A. In all cases where a police officer of East Norriton Township shall first give notice of the offense by either handing to the offending operator or affixing to the motor vehicle in question, a ticket on which he has noted the time and place of the offense, nature of the offense charged, and the license registration of the motor vehicle in question; no prosecution shall be instituted for seventy-two (72) hours thereafter, provided that, if during the said seventy-two (72) hour period, the offender shall voluntarily appear at the office of the Township Secretary of East Norriton Township during regular business hours and voluntarily enter a plea of guilty and pay a fine of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) to the Township, no prosecution for such offense shall thereafter be brought.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
