

NOTICE OF ORDINANCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township to be held on Tuesday, September 2, 1952, at 8 o'clock, P. M., D. S. T., at the Norriton Fire Engine Company Fire House, Penn Square, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, the said Supervisors propose to enact the following ordinance:

ORDINANCE NO. 11

PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES OR PERMITTING VEHICLES TO STAND, WHETHER ATTENDED OR UNATTENDED, UPON HIGHWAYS IN EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, WHERE IT IS DESIGNATED BY OFFICIAL SIGNS THAT PARKING IS PROHIBITED AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED and enacted by the Township of East Norriton, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION 1: That hereafter no vehicle shall be parked or permitted to stand, whether attended or unattended, upon any highway in East Norriton Township where it is designated by an official sign that parking is forbidden; that the said Board shall order the placing of said official signs, after reasonable investigation, to insure the public safety and promote the public welfare; provided, however, that "parking" or "permitting to stand" shall not include any vehicle standing or waiting on any highway in obedience to traffic regulations, or traffic signals, or actually engaged in taking up or setting down passengers or merchandise.

SECTION 2: Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall upon summary conviction before any justice of the peace having jurisdiction within said township, be sentenced to pay a fine for the use of said township, of not less than Two Dollars (\$2.00), nor more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00), and pay costs of prosecution, and in default of payment thereof, shall be committed to the county jail for a period not exceeding five (5) days.
