ORDINANCE NO. 115

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 68 WHICH MAKES IT UNLAWFUL TO INJURE, REMOVE OR TAMPER WITH REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST NORRITON, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of East Norriton, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, that Section 2 of Ordinance No. 68 is amended to read as follows:

Section 2. With permission of the owner of any property temporary show cards, posters or other advertising devices not larger than 12" x 18" may be placed for a period not exceeding twenty-one (21) days upon deposit with the Township Secretary of a certified check in the amount of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars to be held in escrow to guarantee the removal of the temporary show cards, posters or other advertising devices upon the expiration of the twenty-one (21) day period. If the temporary show cards, posters or other advertising devices have been removed at the expiration of the twenty-one (21) day period, the Township Secretary shall refund the Fifty (\$50.00) Dollar check. If the temporary show cards, posters or other advertising devices have not been removed, the escrow deposit shall be forfeited and the temporary show cards, posters or other advertising devices shall be removed at the direction of the Township Secretary by Township employees. This temporary permit may be renewed for one (1) additional twenty-one (21) day period only.
