Vacation of Public Road

This is notice of the passage of the hereinafter recited Ordinance by the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, at a regular meeting held on Tuesday, January 5, 1954.

ORDINANCE NO. 13

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of East Norriton that pursuant to the authority and the proceedings conducted under Sections 15 and 16 of Article XI of the Act of July 10, 1947, F.L. 1481, as amended by the Act of May 24, 1951, F.L. 370, that portion of Butchers Mill Road as originally opened by the Court of Quarter Sessions on November 13, 1855, with a width of thirty-three feet, lying between that point where said road meets or intersects with the southeasterly side of another road, sometimes called Butchers Mill Road but later referred to as Butchers Lane, and terminating where said road meets or intersects with the northwesterly side of Hannah Avenue, as shown on plan of said road dated November 7, 1953, as prepared by Donald H. Schurr, and duly recorded with the proceedings filed in the office of the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions, in and for Montgomery County, designated as No. 10, November Term, 1953, is hereby vacated as a public road.
