

ORDINANCE NO. 19.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE OF 1955, SO AS TO CHANGE THE ZONING MAP AND A CERTAIN DISTRICT THEREON, FROM A RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT TO A COMMERCIAL DISTRICT.

The Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, does hereby ordain and enact as follows:

The hereinafter described Residential District as shown on Zoning Map, provided under Article III, Section 301 of the East Norriton Township Zoning Ordinance of 1955, shall be changed upon said Zoning Map from a Residential District to a Commercial District:

ALL THAT CERTAIN lot or piece of ground with the improvements thereon consisting of a house, barn, and warehouse, bounded and described as follows, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point approximately one hundred feet Southeast of Trooper Road on the Northeast side of Germantown Pike; thence extending along the same the distance of five hundred eight feet to a point, a corner of land owned by or for the benefit of the Valley Forge Heart Hospital; thence extending at right angles to the center line of Germantown Pike a distance of one hundred eighty-one feet to a point a corner; thence extending more or less parallel to Germantown Pike five hundred twelve feet to a corner in line now or late of O'Donnell; thence extending along the land of O'Donnell and Norriton-Lower Providence Presbyterian Church the distance of two hundred fifty-six feet to the point and place of beginning.
