

ORDINANCE no. 53

AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE FIRE PREVENTION CODE AS
AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 43 AND ALSO BY ORDINANCE NO. 48

The Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery
County, Pa., hereby enacts and ordains as follows:

The Fire Prevention Code as adopted in Ordinance No. 43,
supplemented and amended by Section 7 of the same, and which
Section 7 was further supplemented and amended by Ordinance No.
48, is hereby further supplemented and amended as follows:

Section 7. Any person who shall violate any of the pro-
visions of the Code hereby adopted or fails to comply there-
with or who shall violate or fail to comply with any order
made thereunder or who shall build in violation of any detailed
statement or specifications or plans submitted and approved
thereunder or any certificate or permit issued thereunder and
from which no appeal has been taken or who upon appeal shall
fail to comply with such an order as affirmed or modified by
the Supervisors or by a court of competent jurisdiction within
the time fixed herein shall severally for each and every such
violation and non-compliance upon summary conviction before a
justice of the peace to be sentenced to pay a fine of not less
than \$25 and not more than \$100 or in default of payment thereof
by imprisonment for not more than 5 days. The imposition of one
(1) penalty for any violation shall not excuse the violation or
permit it to continue and all such persons shall be required to
correct or remedy such violations or defects forthwith. Each
day that prohibited conditions are maintained shall constitute
a new and separate offense.

The applications of the above penalty shall not be held to
prevent the enforced removal of prohibited conditions.

When the Chief of the Bureau of Fire Prevention has declared a
prohibition on any or all bonfires and outdoor rubbish fires
because atmospheric conditions or local circumstances make such
fires hazardous, the fines and penalties shall be double the
amounts hereinbefore provided, for any violation involving bon-
fires and outdoor rubbish fires during such period of time.
