

ORDINANCE NO. 57

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 29, ORDAINED AND ENACTED JANUARY 4, 1960, WHICH PROVIDED FOR CONNECTIONS WITH THE PUBLIC SANITARY SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEM.

The Supervisors of East Norriton Township hereby Ordain and Enact as follows:

Ordinance No. 29, Ordained and Enacted January 4, 1960, providing for connections with the Public Sanitary Sewer Collection System is hereby amended so that the present Sections 7 and 11 shall be deleted and in their place Sections 7 and 11 shall now read as follows:

Section 7. It shall be unlawful and a violation of this Ordinance for any owner of an occupied building on property accessible to the Sewer System to fail to connect such property with the Sewer System within 90 days after having received notice to do so from the Township.


Section 11. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Township and persons violating any provisions of this Ordinance, upon conviction before a Justice of the Peace within the Magisterial District of which the Township of East Norriton is a part, shall be fined not less than \$50.00 and not more than \$300.00 and costs. Each 30-day period during which such violation of such provision shall continue, shall be deemed to be a separate offence. Each occupied building, as hereinbefore defined, whether or not the owners thereof shall be permitted to connect two or more occupied buildings or units by a single connection to a lateral of the sewer system or shall be required to make separate connections for each occupied building or unit, shall constitute a separate and distinct unit under the provisions of this Ordinance and the persons owning occupied buildings, consisting of multiple units contained in the same structure, who violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be subject to the aforesaid fine for each and every one of such occupied buildings or units which are in violation of the provisions of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this Ordinance be and the same are hereby Repealed.
