

ORDINANCE NO. 68

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO INJURE, REMOVE OR TAMPER WITH REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST NORRITON, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Supervisors of the Township of East Norriton, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, partnership, association or corporation to

(a) willfully, maliciously, wantonly, negligently or otherwise injure, deface, destroy or remove real property or improvements thereto, or personal property belonging to the Township of East Norriton.

(b) throw or permit to be deposited or scattered upon any sidewalk, alley, street or other public passageway any waste or other material of any kind.

(c) fasten in any way any show card, poster or other advertising device upon public or private property in the Township unless legally authorized to do so by the owner thereof.

(d) tamper with, injure, deface, destroy or remove any sign, notice, marker, fire alarm, fire hydrant, topographical survey monument or any other personal property erected or placed by the Township.

Section 2. With permission of the owner of any property temporary show cards, posters or other advertising devices may be placed for a period not exceeding twenty-one (21) days upon

deposit with the Township Secretary of a certified check in the amount of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars to be held in escrow to guarantee the removal of the temporary show cards, posters or other advertising devices upon the expiration of the twenty-one (21) day period. If the temporary show cards, posters or other advertising devices have all been removed at the expiration of the twenty-one (21) day period, the Township Secretary shall refund the Fifty (\$50.00) Dollar check. If the temporary show cards, posters or other advertising devices have not been removed, the escrow deposit shall be forfeited and the temporary show cards, posters or other advertising devices shall be removed at the direction of the Township Secretary by Township employees.

Section 3. Any person, partnership, association or corporation violating this ordinance or causing or helping others to violate it, shall upon being adjudged guilty thereof in any proceeding brought before the District Justice in and for the said Township, be sentenced to pay a fine for the use of said Township of not less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars, nor more than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars, for each offense, and in default of paying said fine and all costs accrued, such person, the members of such partnership or the officers of such association or corporation shall be committed to the County Jail for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days. Said penalty shall be in addition to any civil remedy on the part of the Township.
