

ORDINANCE NO. 72

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP
PLUMBING CODE KNOWN AS ORDINANCE NO. 52

The Supervisors of East Norriton Township hereby ordain
and enact as follows:

The East Norriton Township Plumbing Code known as Ordinance
No. 52 is hereby supplemented and amended as follows:

PART I

2. REGISTRATION, e. Registration fees is hereby amended
so that the same shall now read as follows:

The annual registration fees for plumbers shall be as
follows:

- Master Plumber.....\$10.00
- Sewage disposal system contractor.....\$ 5.00
- Journeyman Plumber.....\$ 2.00
- Apprentice Plumber.....\$ 1.00

Non-Resident Plumber - Reciprocal Job Registration Fee.

A non-resident Plumber must pay the standard permit fees
and file a Master Plumber's Bond.

When a plumber is from a Municipality where there is no
plumbing code or provisions have not been made for an approved
registration, then he shall be required to register in the approved
Municipality nearest to his place of residence and must also
pay a reciprocal job registration fee equal in amount to the
amount charged by the Municipality in which he is so registered
or a minimum of \$10.00 whichever is greater.

He shall pay any and all transit fees according to the
fees as charged by the Municipality in which he is registered on
a reciprocal basis.

This fee is to be paid for each permit which a non-resident
plumber obtains to do work in East Norriton.

When Municipalities, other than First, Second and Third Class Cities require plumbers properly registered in East Norriton Township to take examinations to perform plumbing work in such Municipality, then plumbers from that Municipality shall also be required to take an examination in East Norriton Township before being registered and allowed to perform work in East Norriton Township.

Delinquent Registration Fees.

All Plumbers who fail to re-register for the following year by the thirty-first day of December shall be considered as delinquent, and they shall pay an additional delinquency fee as follows prior to re-registering:

Delinquent Master Plumber.....	\$10.00
Delinquent Journeyman Plumber.....	\$ 2.00
Delinquent Apprentice Plumber.....	\$ 1.00

5. SUBMISSION OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS

c. Plumbing Permit Fees is hereby amended so that the same shall now read as follows:

c. Plumbing Permit Fees

The Board of Supervisors shall establish a fee schedule in which shall be listed the various fees for plumbing permits which will be charged when a plumbing permit is issued based on the approved plans and specifications in accordance with this ordinance. Said fee schedule may be amended from time to time as deemed necessary by resolution of the Board of Supervisors.

PART II

1. INTENT AND BASIC PRINCIPLES - First paragraph shall be amended to read as follows:

The basic principles of this code are given as basic goals in environmental sanitation worthy of accomplishment through properly designed, acceptably installed, and adequately maintained plumbing systems. Some of the details of plumbing construction must vary, but the basic sanitary and safety principles are the same. The results desired and necessary to protect the health of the people are the same everywhere. The following principles constitute the basic

mandatory requirements for proper sanitation. Furthermore, as unforeseen situations arise which are not covered in the body of the code, the principles may serve to define the intent.

PART II 1. INTENT AND BASIC PRINCIPLES

Principle No. 6 shall be amended to read as follows:

Each family dwelling unit on premises abutting on a sewer or with a private sewage disposal system shall have at least one water closet, one kitchen-type sink, a lavatory and bath tub or shower which meets the basic requirements of sanitation and personal hygiene.

All other structures for human occupancy or use on premises abutting on a sewer or with a private sewage-disposal system shall have adequate sanitary facilities which shall be separate for each sex for persons employed on the premises in accordance with the following table:

NO. OF PEOPLE	TOILETS	WASH BASINS
1-15	1	1
16-30	2	2
31-50	3	3

4. QUALITY AND WEIGHT OF MATERIALS

f. Permitted Uses

The table in this section shall be amended by deleting the X in the column entitled Bldg. Sewer on the line Clay Perforated Pipe or Tile Drains.

PART II

9. PLUMBING FIXTURES

K. Requirements for Places of Public Assembly shall be amended to read as follows:

k. Requirements for Places of Public Assembly including movie theatres, bowling alleys, bars, ~~places of public worship~~, *pub* restaurants, cafeterias, service stations and other similar establishments.

In all places of public assembly the minimum requirements for each sex for toilets and wash basins shall be according to the following table:

NO. OF PEOPLE	TOILETS	WASH BASINS
1-15	1	1
16-30	2	2
31-50	3	3

Each additional 25 people requires one additional toilet except in the Men's Room where one urinal may be substituted in lieu of a toilet.

PART II

18. Penalties shall be amended by adding a third paragraph as follows:


The intent of this ordinance is to prescribe regulations which are additional or supplementary to any statute and not to be inconsistent therewith. This ordinance is also enacted for the purpose of carrying into effect the provisions of the statute law. In the event that the provisions of this ordinance are deemed by the owner of any structure other than a family dwelling unit to constitute an unnecessary hardship then an appeal to the Board of Supervisors for a variance from the terms of this ordinance may be made from the decision of the Plumbing Officer. An appeal for a variance from the terms of this ordinance shall be made in writing to the Board of Supervisors not more than 10 days after the decision of the Plumbing Inspector setting forth the decision appealed from and the reasons why a variance should be granted. The Board may determine the grant or refusal of a variance on the basis of the letter appeal or may meet with the appellant concerning this matter. This provision shall not in any way alter or detract from an appeal for a variance to the Department of Labor and Industry. Any such variance granted by the Department of Labor and Industry will be recognized by East Norriton Township.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
