

ORDINANCE NO. 94

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE OF TOWNSHIP RECREATIONAL AREAS AND PARKS.

The Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, pursuant to the Second Class Township Code, Act of 1933, P.L. 103, Article XIX, Section 1904, 53 P.S. 66904, as amended, and upon the recommendation of the Park and Recreation Board, enact and ordain the following:

EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP PARKS'
RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The following rules and regulations are applicable to all East Norriton Township Park and Recreation areas.
2. The parks are open to all Township residents and guests from sunrise until sunset throughout the year, except special events such as ice skating and other similar activities authorized by the Park and Recreation Board *and/or the Board of Supervisors.*
3. Use of the facilities by organized groups shall be scheduled at the Office at the Township Building.
4. Children under the age of six (6) years must be accompanied by an adult.
5. THE FOLLOWING ARE PROHIBITED:
 - (a) Possession or use of malt^{or}/alcoholic beverages or drugs which are possessed in violation of law.
 - (b) Boisterous, immoral or indecent conduct.
 - (c) Gambling.
 - (d) Discarding of trash, garbage, or other litter except into container provided for that purpose.
 - (e) Damaging, defacing, destroying, or moving Township-owned property, trees, shrubs, signs, structures, equipment, or other material.
 - (f) Parking of any vehicle except on designated areas.
 - (g) Possession or discharge of any type of firearms.
 - (h) Fires, except in facilities provided for such purpose.
 - (i) Pets, except when kept on a leash not exceeding six (6) feet in length.

- (j) Swimming in pond or throwing any objects into pond.
- (k) Any fishing in pond which violates the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Regulations concerning licensing ~~of~~ or seasons.
- (l) Minibikes, motorcycles, go-carts, or other self-propelled vehicles other than automobiles in parking areas.
- (m) Trapping of animals.
- (n) Archery, except in specially designated areas.

6. Any person violating any provision herein shall be guilty of a summary offense and upon conviction thereof shall be liable for a fine of not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or in default thereof to imprisonment for not more than five (5) days.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
