

ORDINANCE NO. 98

EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP  
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR REGULATING STANDING AND PARKING OF VEHICLES ON PUBLIC ROADS AND STREETS IN EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 11; AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 82 BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION III (a). AND FURTHER PROVIDING A METHOD UNDER WHICH VIOLATORS OF THE TERMS OF THIS ORDINANCE AND ORDINANCE NO. 82 MAY VOLUNTARILY PAY A FINE AND AVOID PROSECUTION.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township as follows:

SECTION I - No person shall park a vehicle or tractor or permit it to stand, whether tended or unattended, upon a highway, or in any of the following places;

- (a) Within an intersection;
- (b) On a crosswalk;
- (c) Between a safety zone and the adjacent curb, or within 30 feet of points on the curb immediately opposite the ends of a safety zone, unless local officials shall indicate a different length by signs or markings;
- (d) Within 25 feet from the intersection of curb lines, or, if none, then within 15 feet of the intersection of property lines at an intersection of highways;
- (e) Within 30 feet upon the approach to any official flashing signal, stop sign, or traffic signal located at the side of the roadway;
- (f) Within 15 feet of the driveway entrance to any fire station;
- (g) Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant;
- (h) On a sidewalk;
- (i) In front of a private driveway, or along side any street or highway excavation or obstruction, nor opposite the same, unless a clear and unobstructed width of not less than 20 feet upon the main traveled portion of the said street or highway shall be left free for passage of other vehicles thereon;

- (j) On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the curb or edge of the highway;
- (k) At any place where official signs have been erected prohibiting standing and parking;
- (l) Except when necessary in obedience to traffic regulations or traffic signs, signals, or where angle parking is permitted, the operator of a vehicle on the highway within a business or residence district, other than parallel with the edge of the highway or curb. Vehicles, which because of type or construction cannot load or unload parallel to the curb, shall be exempt, while loading or unloading only, from the requirements of standing parallel to the curb.

SECTION II - It shall be the duty of the Road Foreman acting in concert with the Chief of Police or the duty of the Township Fire Marshal to designate and post official signs in those places where, in the exercise of their discretion, restrictions on parking or standing of vehicles or tractors should be imposed, without any further action of the Board of Supervisors.

SECTION III - Any person violating any of the provisions of Section I shall, upon summary conviction before a District Justice, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Ten (\$10) Dollars, and costs of prosecution; and, in default of the payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment for not more than five (5) days, except that in all cases where a Police Officer of East Norriton Township, the Township Fire Marshal, or his duly authorized representative shall first give notice of the offense by either handing to the offending operator, or affixing to the motor vehicle in question, a ticket on which he has noted the time and place of the offense, nature of the offense charged, and the license registration of the motor vehicle in question; no prosecution shall be instituted for 72 hours thereafter, provided that, if during the said 72 hour period, the offender shall voluntarily appear at the Office of the Township Secretary of East Norriton Township during regular business hours and voluntarily enter a plea of guilty and pay a fine of Five (\$5) Dollars to the Township, no prosecution for such offense shall thereafter be brought.

SECTION IV - It is further enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township that Ordinance No. 82 shall be amended to the extent that a new Section III (a). shall be added thereto, which shall read as follows:

SECTION III (a). In all cases where a Police Officer of East Norriton Township shall first give notice of the offense by either handing to the offending operator, or affixing to the motor vehicle in question, a ticket on which he has noted the time and place of the offense, nature of the offense charged, and

the license registration of the motor vehicle in question; no prosecution shall be instituted for 72 hours thereafter, provided that, if during the said 72 hour period, the offender shall voluntarily appear at the office of the Township Secretary of East Norriton Township during regular business hours and voluntarily enter a plea of guilty and pay a fine of Ten (\$10) Dollars to the Township, no prosecution for such offense shall thereafter be brought.

SECTION V - Nothing contained in this Ordinance shall be construed to prevent a home owner or his permitted guest from parking in front of the driveway entrance for his own home.

SECTION VI - Ordinance No. 11 and all Ordinances and parts thereof that are inconsistent herewith, are, to the extent of said inconsistency, hereby repealed.
