

ORDINANCE NO. 152

Township of East Norriton

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE "BATHING AND SWIMMING POOL ORDINANCE OF EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP" (ORDINANCE NO. 59, AS AMENDED) BY REQUIRING EACH APPLICANT FOR AN ANNUAL SWIMMING POOL LICENSE TO DEMONSTRATE A SATISFACTORY METHOD OF DISPOSING OF WATER TO AVOID DRAINAGE ONTO SURROUNDING PROPERTIES AND PROVIDING FOR FINES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of East Norriton, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, under and by virtue of the authority granted by the Second Class Township Code, do hereby enact and ordain:

Section 1.

Section 3 of Ordinance No. 59 is amended to read:

Applications for permits shall be made to the Township Zoning Officer on a form to be approved by him and shall include such plans, drawings, specifications, maps and other data as may be required to satisfactorily indicate the location, specific dimensions, area, depth of the pool, and the method of fencing, latching and locking. Applicant shall also demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Zoning Officer the method and manner of backwashing and emptying the pool and disposing of the water from the Applicant's property so as to insure drainage into a public or private underground storm water system and to avoid drainage over or onto surrounding properties.

Section 2.

Section 5 of Ordinance No. 59 shall be supplemented by adding the following:

Any person who backwashes or empties a pool and causes water to drain onto surrounding properties shall be deemed to have violated this Ordinance.
