

ORDINANCE NO. 212

TOWNSHIP OF EAST NORRITON  
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF EAST NORRITON TO PROVIDE FOR THE IMPOSITION OF A TWENTY-FIVE MILE PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT ON ALL HIGHWAYS AND ROADWAYS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST NORRITON AND UNDER SAID JURISDICTION WITH THE EXCEPTION OF ANY STATE OR COUNTY HIGHWAY OR ROADWAY WITHIN EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, it is HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of same as follows:

Section 1. SPEED LIMIT.

- (a) The maximum lawful speed limit on all highways and roadways within the Township of East Norriton and under said jurisdiction with the exception of any state or county highway or roadway within East Norriton Township is 25 m.p.h.
- (b) The Township, by its duly authorized agent, or representative, shall, in accordance with the regulations adopted by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, erect official traffic control devices providing for said 25 m.p.h. speed limit.
- (c) Any person violating Subsection (a) is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$35.00. Any person exceeding the maximum speed limit by more than five (5) miles per hour shall pay an additional fine of \$2.00 for each mile per hour in excess of five (5) miles per hour over the maximum speed limit.

Section 2. INCONSISTENT ORDINANCE REPEALED.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall take effect after approval in accordance with the provisions of the Second Class Township Code.
