

ORDINANCE NO. 217

TOWNSHIP OF EAST NORRITON  
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE AUTHORIZATION AND ERECTION OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES PROHIBITING PARKING ON STANBRIDGE STREET, EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, it is HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of same as follows:

Section 1. NO PARKING.

- (a) It shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle on the new section of Stanbridge Street (fronting the Timberplace Townhouses and Timberlake Apartments) between Germantown Pike and the entrance to the Township Building (opposite Meadowbrook Road), East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, in violation of erected traffic control devices providing for "NO PARKING".
- (b) The Township, by its duly authorized agent or representative shall, in accordance with the regulations adopted by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, erect official traffic control devices providing for "NO PARKING".
- (c) Any person violating subsection (a) is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon a plea of guilty, pay a fine of ten dollars (\$10.00) or shall be subject to the provision of Ordinance Number 176, providing for failure to respond to a parking ticket.

Section 2. INCONSISTENT ORDINANCE REPEALED.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.


This Ordinance shall take effect after approval in accordance with the provisions of the Second Class Township Code.
