

ORDINANCE NO. 229

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 117 GIVING CERTAIN POLICE POWERS TO EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS

The Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, under and by virtue of the authority granted by the Second Class Township Code and the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure, do hereby enact and ordain:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 117, an Ordinance giving certain police powers to East Norriton Township Enforcement Officials, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. The East Norriton Township Code Enforcement Officer, Building Inspector, Fire Marshal, Zoning Officer, Plumbing Inspector, and Parking Enforcement Officer, as well as their deputies and assistants, are hereby granted such police powers as may be necessary to file Complaints, informations and citations before the appropriate District Justice and to issue citations as provided in Rule 51 of the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure.
