

ORDINANCE NO. 239

EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP  
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING EAST NORRITON ORDINANCE NO. 45, THE AMUSEMENT TAX ORDINANCE, AND EAST NORRITON ORDINANCE NO. 121, THE OCCUPATIONAL PRIVILEGE TAX ORDINANCE, TO PROVIDE FOR PAYMENT OF TAXES TO THE TAX COLLECTOR FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST NORRITON AND FURTHER AMENDING EAST NORRITON ORDINANCE NO. 45 TO INCREASE THE FEES FOR PERMITS

The Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, under and by the authority granted by the Second Class Township Code and the Local Tax Enabling Act, do hereby enact and ordain:

Section 1.

The East Norriton Township Amusement Tax Ordinance, Ordinance No. 45, is hereby amended to provide that any reference to the Secretary of the Township of East Norriton shall be deemed to refer to the Director of the Department of Finance of the Township of East Norriton and/or any Township-designated Tax Collector.

Section 2.

East Norriton Township Ordinance No. 121, Section 1F, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"F. Tax Receiver shall mean the "Director of the Department of Finance of the Township of East Norriton and/or any Township-designated Tax Collector."

Section 3.

The East Norriton Township Amusement Tax Ordinance, Ordinance No. 45, Section 4, "Permits", is hereby amended to provide for a permit fee of \$5.00 for each temporary permit and a permit fee of \$10.00 for an annual permit or a duplicate permit.


Section 4.

East Norriton Township Amusement Tax Ordinance, Ordinance No. 45, Section 15, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Any person or any officer, agent, servant or employee thereof who should fail, neglect or refuse to comply with any of the terms or provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction before a District Justice, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) and costs of prosecution for each offense to be collected as other fines and costs are now by law collectible or imprisonment not exceeding ninety (90) days, if the amount of said fine and costs shall not be paid. The fine imposed by this Section shall be in addition to any other penalty imposed by any other Section of this Ordinance. Each day on which such person violated the Ordinance will be considered as a separate offense and punishable as provided herein."
