

ORDINANCE NO. 240

EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EMPLOYMENT OF A PRIVATE AGENCY TO ENGAGE IN TAX COLLECTION FOR EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to streamline tax collection in the Township and believes that private enterprise can most effectively increase the efficiency of tax collection.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, does hereby ordain and enact as follows:

Section 1.

The Department of Finance of East Norriton Township is hereby authorized to retain a private agency to serve as the tax collector for the Township for the collection, administration and enforcement of Ordinances/Resolutions of the Township assessing the Occupational Privilege Tax, the Mercantile Tax, the Business Privilege Tax, the Amusement Tax and the Earned Income Tax.

Section 2.

The Township shall compensate any private agency retained pursuant hereto at such rate as shall be mutually agreeable to the Township and the private agency.

Section 3.

Any Ordinance/Resolution or any part of any Ordinance/Resolution conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
