

ORDINANCE NO. 248

EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING EAST NORRITON ORDINANCE NO. 221, THE BOCA BUILDING CODE (1984), BY MAKING CERTAIN ADDITIONS AND CHANGES TO THE TEXT OF THE BOCA BUILDING CODE (1984) AS SET FORTH IN THE BODY OF THIS ORDINANCE.

The Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, under and by the authority granted by the Second Class Township Code, do hereby enact and ordain:

Section 1.

The East Norriton Township BOCA Building Code (1984), Ordinance No. 221, is hereby amended as follows:

Amend Article VI by adding new Section 623.0 to read as follows:

Section 623.0, Premises Identification. Approved numbers or addresses shall be placed on all new and existing buildings in such a position as to be plainly visible and legible from the street or road fronting the property. Said numbers shall contrast with their background.

Section 1702.0, Fire Suppression Systems. Section 1702.6, Use Groups B, R-1, and R-2, is hereby deleted and new Section 1702.6 is added as follows:

Section 1702.6, Use Groups B, R-1 and R-2 - In all buildings or structures or portions thereof of Use Group B, R-1 and R-2 when more than 5,000 square feet in area.

Section 1713.0, Fire Department Connections. Section 1713.6, Hose Thread, is hereby deleted and new Section 1713.6 is added as follows:


Section 1713.6, Hose Threads - The standardization of the Fire Department standpipe and Fire Department sprinkler connection hose thread to be uniform 3-inch N.S.T. on the Fire Department connection and 2 1/2-inch N.S.T. on the standpipe connections in all existing and proposed buildings.

Section 2.

This Ordinance shall in no other way amend or modify the said BOCA Building Code Ordinance.
