

ORDINANCE NO. 262
EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

An ordinance amending the East Norriton Township Zoning Ordinance of 1963 (Ordinance No. 40), as amended and revised by Ordinance No. 96 by revising the East Norriton Township Floodplain Conservation District Overlay Map to reflect the realignment of an unnamed waterway running through the subdivision known as the Court at Jamestowne.

The Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania under and by virtue of the authority granted by the Second Class Township Code and the Municipalities Planning Code, do hereby enact and ordain:

Section 1.

Whereas, the property at issue is located within the subdivision known as the Court at Jamestowne, located on Arch Street (west side) south of Germantown Pike;

Whereas, the landowner has submitted engineering data proposing to realign an existing unnamed waterway running over a portion of the subdivision known as The Court at Jamestowne;

Whereas, this engineering data has been reviewed by the Township Engineer, the East Norriton Township Planning Commission, the Montgomery County Planning Commission, the Montgomery County Conservation District, and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Environmental Resources;

Now, therefore, the Township of East Norriton hereby declares that the unnamed waterway running through the subdivision known as The Court at Jamestowne as realigned shall

be shown on the East Norriton Township Floodplain Conservation District Overlay Map.

Section 2.

All ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
