

ORDINANCE NO. 281

EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP  
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP SPECIFICALLY THE EMPLOYEE PENSION PLAN ORDINANCE NO. 161 BY CHANGING THE NORMAL RETIREMENT AGE FROM SIXTY-FIVE TO SIXTY-TWO.

The Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, under and by virtue of authority granted by the Second Class Township Code, does hereby enact and ordain:

Section 1.

Section 26 1.a. (1) The East Norriton Township Employee Pension Plan Ordinance No. 161, being Chapter 26 of the Code of East Norriton Township is hereby amended as follows:

A. Age and Service. Each full time, permanent, non-uniformed employee of the Township of East Norriton who shall have 10 years of aggregate service with the Township and who shall have attained 62 years of age shall be entitled to retire and to receive pension or retirement benefits as hereinafter provided.

Section 2.

This change is retroactive to January 1, 1989.

Section 3.


This Ordinance shall in no other way amend or modify the said Employee Pension Plan Ordinance No. 161.
