

**ORDINANCE NO. 444**

**EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP**

**MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

**AN ORDINANCE OF EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST NORRITON, BY AMENDING CHAPTER 196 “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC” RELATIVE TO PARKING VIOLATIONS.**

**SECTION I. AMENDMENT OF THE CODE.**

Chapter 196 “Vehicles and Traffic” is hereby amended to add the following:

**Section 196-19.C.:** No person shall park a vehicle at any time within the Township of East Norriton in such a way that any part of such vehicle:

- 1) is located within 15 feet of a fire hydrant;
- 2) is located on a public sidewalk;
- 3) is located in a designated fire zone;
- 4) is located within 20 feet of an intersection;
- 5) blocks or impedes ingress or egress from a public or private driveway;
- 6) is located within a designated “Handicap Only” parking space;
- 7) is located within a pedestrian crosswalk; or
- 8) blocks or impedes the flow of traffic in any way.

**SECTION II. SEVERABILITY.**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provisions shall be separate, distinct and independent, and such holding shall not effect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION III. RATIFICATION.**

This Ordinance shall in no other way affect, amend or modify the Vehicles and Traffic Ordinance contained in Chapter 196 of the Code of East Norriton Township.

**SECTION IV. FAILURE TO ENFORCE NOT A WAIVER.**

The failure of the Township to enforce any provision of this Ordinance shall not constitute a waiver by the Township of its rights of future enforcement hereunder.
