

ORDINANCE NO. 549

**EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP,
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST NORRITON, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 54 "ALARM DEVICES" OF THE EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, East Norriton Township, by Ordinance 165, adopted October 19, 1981, established violations and penalties for the false transmission of alarms to the Township Police Department and the Norriton Fire Engine Company, currently Chapter 54 of the East Norriton Township Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to amend the violations and penalties prescribed in Chapter 54 of the East Norriton Township Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is authorized to adopt and amend Ordinances regulating the general and specific powers of the Township pursuant to Section 1601(a) of the Second Class Township Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it, and it is hereby ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED and ORDAINED by authority of same as follows:

I. TEXT AMENDMENT:

Chapter 54 "Alarm Devices" of the East Norriton Township Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by deleting the existing §54-5.A(2) through §54-5.A(4) and inserting the following:

§54-5.A(2) For the second offense, a fine in an amount not to exceed \$100.00, plus costs.

§54-5.A(3) For the third offense, a fine in an amount not to exceed \$200.00, plus costs.

§54-5.A(4) For the fourth offense and subsequent offenses, a fine in an amount not to exceed \$400.00, plus costs.


II. GENERAL REPEALER: All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.

III. SAVINGS CLAUSE: If any provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such determination shall have no effect on the remaining provisions of this Ordinance or on the provisions of the Code of Ordinances of East Norriton Township.


- IV. NO WAIVER: The failure of East Norriton Township to enforce any provision of this ordinance shall not constitute a waiver by East Norriton Township of its rights of future enforcement hereunder.

- V. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be effective five days after its adoption by the East Norriton Township Board of Supervisors.

ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania this 22nd day of October, 2013.




TOWNSHIP OF EAST NORRITON:
