

RESOLUTION NO. 1918

EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP

MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE MODIFICATION OF THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT GERMANTOWN PIKE AND STANBRIDGE STREET IN EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP TO ALLOW FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A LEFT-TURN ARROW.

WHEREAS, the East Norriton Township Board of Supervisors, Montgomery County, desires to modify the operation of the traffic signal on Germantown Pike at Stanbridge Street, and

WHEREAS, the Vehicle Code requires the approval of the Secretary of Transportation before any traffic signal can legally erected or reconstructed, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation requires an engineering drawing of the location of the traffic signal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that approval of the traffic signal at the above mentioned location, by the Secretary of Transportation, is hereby requested, and that East Norriton Township shall prepare such drawing and take such further actions as may be necessary for the installation of the above traffic control device.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, in the event a traffic signal modification permit is approved after proper investigation, the Township of East Norriton will be bound to have it installed and maintained in accordance with the Vehicle Code and the Regulations of traffic signs, signals and markings of the Department of Transportation, and

Should future highway or traffic conditions, or legal requirements, necessitate alterations of the construction or operations, hours of operation, or removal of the traffic signals at the above mentioned location, they shall be altered or removed when and as directed by the Secretary of Transportation.
