PROCLAMATION

Whereas, the citizens and officials of *East Norriton Township* and the citizens and officials of *Berlin Treptow-Köpenick* share the common bond of freedom and democracy and have participated in a varied exchange program since 1991 with *Treptow* and since 1.1.2001 with the combined borough of *Treptow-Köpenick*; and


Whereas, this exchange program has resulted in a number of mutual visits between officials and citizens of both municipalities further establishing a spirit of friendship and cooperation; and
