A PROCLAMATION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP PROCLAIMING SUNDAY, OCTOBER 6TH THRU 12TH, 2002 AS "NATIONAL OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE WEEK" IN EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, there are millions of Americans with health insurance for whom cost is still a barrier to care; and

WHEREAS, the osteopathic medical profession of the United States has recognized that many barriers to access to affordable health and medical care exist; and






