WHEREAS, Edward R. Solvibile, has announced his desire to retire from the position of CEO of Mercy Suburban Hospital, effective September 1, 2003, ending an outstanding career which spanned over 32 years; and

WHEREAS, Edward R. Solvibile grew up in the West Oak Lane section of Philadelphia and graduated from La Salle College High School in 1958 and earned an accounting degree at Temple University in 1963; and

WHEREAS, during his employment as a certified public accountant for Dreslin and Co. did the quarterly audits of the hospital's books and became controller of the facility in 1971; and

WHEREAS, Edward R. Solvibile was in 1979 promoted to associate administrator and to vice president in 1980, and is now stepping down from the post of President which he has held since 1985; and


