A PROCLAMATION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP PROCLAIMING SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 20<sup>TH</sup> THRU 27<sup>TH</sup>, 2003 AS "NATIONAL OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE WEEK" IN EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, there are currently more than 49,000 osteopathic physicians (D.O.s) in the United States; and

WHEREAS, D.O.s have made tremendous contributions to the American health care system since it was founded by Andrew Taylor Still, M.D., D.O., in 1874; and

WHEREAS, D.O.s believe that a person's lifestyle (including their home, work and social environments) can play a significant role in the health of that individual; and

WHEREAS, D.O.s practice OMT, which is a hands-on, whole body approach to diagnose health problems, treat dysfunctions, preserve good health and prevent spread of disease; and

WHEREAS, D.O.s have treated U.S. presidents, Olympic athletes, contributed to the fight against AIDS and the fight for civil rights, served on nationwide health care panels; and

WHEREAS, East Norriton's practicing osteopathic physicians are dedicated to improving the health of their community through education and awareness-based efforts, as well as by delivering quality health services; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of East Norriton recognize the need for osteopathic physicians who are committed to improving the health of Americans, regardless of age, income level or ethnicity;

NOW THEREFORE the East Norriton Township Board of Supervisors, do hereby proclaim September 20-27, 2003, to be National Osteopathic Medicine Week, and urge all citizens and community organizations to support this observance by helping to educate residents about D.O.s and osteopathic medicine.

Proclaimed this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of September, 2003.


