A PROCLAMATION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP GIVING RECOGNITION TO PLYMOUTH COMMUNITY AMBULANCE

WHEREAS, November 1st, 2003 marks the 40th anniversary of Plymouth Community Ambulance; and

WHEREAS, Plymouth Community Ambulance started its service to the community in November 1963, with one ambulance and has built its fleet to include seven Advance Life Support ambulances, one Scene Command/Paramedic Response vehicle and two officer's vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Plymouth Community Ambulance began its service with thirty volunteers and now consists of Bike EMS and SWAT trained paramedics, with over 100 volunteer and career members; and


WHEREAS, Plymouth Community Ambulance was the first squad in 1979 to send twelve of its members to the newly established advanced life support program which we all know now as paramedics; and

WHEREAS, Plymouth Community Ambulance provides 24 hour service to the Townships of Plymouth, Whitpain, East Norriton, Worcester and West Norriton and the Boroughs of Bridgeport and Norristown, and the Pennsylvania Turnpike as well as the Blue Route; and

WHEREAS, Plymouth Community Ambulance is an asset to the communities which it serves by also doing standbys at over 75 events each year which include High School Football games, Township Day fairs, Special events and Fire Prevention exhibits.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, does commend and congratulate Plymouth Community Ambulance on the occasion of its 40th anniversary celebration.
