**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF EAST NORRITON  
ESTABLISHING A SEWAGE SURCHARGE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ORDINANCE  
NUMBER 456.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township passed Ordinance No. 456 on August 26, 2003, creating a surcharge for unlawful discharges into the Township sewer system, for failure to timely repair defective sewer apparatus and/or for failure to grant access to property for inspections for defective apparatus or unlawful discharges.

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 456 mandated a ratio of wet weather flow to dry weather flow to determine the appropriate amount for the surcharge.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors desire to define the surcharge in accordance with Ordinance No. 456.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors desire to enforce Ordinance 456 by authorizing the issuance of letters informing property owners in violation that a surcharge will be imposed upon them.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township as follows:

1. That the sewage surcharge mandated in Ordinance No. 456 shall be Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00). Said surcharge represents the ratio of the average Township increase of wet weather flow in conjunction with the average Township sewer bill for a total of Thirty-Four Dollars (\$34.00). The surcharge further includes a One Dollar (\$1.00) administration fee.
2. That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the issuance of notification letters informing property owners in violation of Ordinance No. 456 that the surcharge in the amount of Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00) will be applied to their quarterly sewer bill.
