WHEREAS, PennSTAR's Mission Statement is "To Provide Rapid Transport of the Critically Ill or Injured Patient"; and

WHEREAS, PennSTAR's program began patient flights in the Summer of 1988, with the first patient flight being a scene in Valley Forge National Park, requested by Berwyn Fire Company and Medic 92 from Chester County, PA.; and

WHEREAS; Since then PennSTAR has transported over 10,000 patients and there are currently four helicopters, with PennSTAR 1 based at Wings Field in Blue Bell, PA where it serves Montgomery, Bucks and Chester counties; and

WHEREAS, Of the thousands of patients who ride on PennSTAR flights, the overwhelming majority are taken to HUP, with PennSTAR also making dropoffs at other hospitals including Presbyterian Medical Center and Pennsylvania Hospital,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, hereby declares PennSTAR Flight as the primary Air Medical Service for the Township.
