

RESOLUTION No. 2320

EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP

MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE REVISION AND MODIFICATION OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL ON GERMANTOWN PIKE APPROXIMATELY 990 FEET WEST OF THE INTERSECTION OF ARCH ROAD IN EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP. (EC & NORTHWOODS)

WHEREAS, the East Norriton Township Board of Supervisors, Montgomery County, desire to modify, operate and maintain a traffic signal on Germantown Pike approximately 990 feet west of Arch Road, and

WHEREAS, the Vehicle Code requires the approval of the Secretary of Transportation before any traffic signal be legally modified, revised, erected or reconstructed, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation requires an engineering drawing of the location of the signal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that a traffic signal be modified at the above mentioned location, subject to the approval of the Secretary of Transportation, and that his approval is hereby requested, and that East Norriton Township shall prepare such drawings and take such further actions as may be necessary for the modification of the traffic signal.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, in the event a revised traffic signal permit is approved after proper investigation, the Township of East Norriton will be bound, that the traffic signal shall be modified and maintained in accordance with the Vehicle Code and Regulations of traffic signs, signals and markings of the Department of Transportation, and


Should future highway or traffic conditions, or legal requirements, necessitate alterations of the construction or operation, or hours of operation, or removal of the traffic signals at the above mentioned location, they shall be altered or removed when and as directed by the Secretary of Transportation.
