**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST NORRITON  
IN SUPPORT OF SENATE BILL 1228, PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEE  
RETIREMENT COMMISSION TO PERFORM AN ANALYSIS OF PENNSYLVANIA'S  
MUNICIPAL PENSION PLANS AND COST PROJECTIONS.**

**WHEREAS**, public sector pension plans in Pennsylvania and across the United States are now in a state of crisis; and

**WHEREAS**, for too long state legislatures have ignored the problem, failing to adequately examine the issue and take action to avert a crisis; and

**WHEREAS**, regular analysis of Pennsylvania's municipal pension plans and cost projections on a state-wide level would provide valuable information to both inform Pennsylvania lawmakers and compel them to address both the present and future cost of funding municipal pension plans; and

**WHEREAS**, Senate Bill 1228 provides that the Public Employee Retirement Commission shall perform this analysis and make its findings available to the legislature and the public.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township supports Senate Bill 1228 and urges its state elected officials, the Pennsylvania State Association of Township Supervisors and the Montgomery County Association of Township Officials to also lend their support.
