A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST NORRITON COMMITTING TO THE COMPLETION OF THE GERMANTOWN PIKE TRAFFIC SIGNAL INTERCONNECTION PROJECT, SUBJECT TO FUNDING THROUGH THE AUTOMATED RED LIGHT ENFORCEMENT (ARLE) TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT GRANTS PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors for the Township of East Norriton recognizes the need to safely and efficiently move vehicles and pedestrians along Germantown Pike, and further recognizes both the economic and quality of life benefits to the residents and businesses of the Township by the efficient flow of traffic through this major commuter corridor; and,

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation has made available grant monies through the Automated Red Light Enforcement (ARLE) Transportation Enhancement Grants Program to enhance safety and mobility; and,


WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, at their November 16, 2010 public meeting, unanimously authorized Township Staff and the Township's Traffic Engineer, Traffic Planning & Design, Inc., to apply for grant monies under this program for the purpose of constructing a fiber optic interconnection of various traffic signals along Germantown Pike; and,

WHEREAS, on November 30, 2010, Traffic Planning & Design, Inc. submitted an application for the Germantown Pike Traffic Signal Interconnection Project under the ARLE grant program in the amount of \$271,300.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of East Norriton that the Township will construct the Germantown Pike Traffic Signal Interconnection Project provided the applied for grant monies are awarded.
