

RESOLUTION NO. 2539

**EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, by ordinance and as authorized by the Second Class Township Code, has designated the Norriton Fire Engine Company as the Fire Department for East Norriton Township; and

WHEREAS, the East Norriton Township Board of Supervisors recognizes the high risks associated with the activity of "basement pumping". These high risks include electrocution and hazardous materials exposure to our responders as well as transferring liability from the residence to the township if hazardous materials are pumped out of the basement and into our storm water system.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Township of East Norriton supports the recommendation from the Norriton Fire Engine Company to terminate, effective August 1, 2011, the practice of "basement pumping" other than during incidents of life safety emergencies.
