**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE
DVRPC TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM FOR THE
CALVERT HURDLE PARK STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, East Norriton Township (“Township”) recognizes the recurring flooding issues in the area of Calvert Hurdle Park, which result in the inundation of portions of North Wales Road, as well as upstream residential neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Township seeks to protect the health of its citizens and enhance the quality of life for its residents, in part by improving stormwater management facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to undertake the Calvert Hurdle Park Stormwater Management Project to address and mitigate the flooding issues described previously; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to apply to the Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission (DVRPC) for grant funding through the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) for the purpose of carrying out this project; and

WHEREAS, the Township has received and understands the TAP Guidelines and Procedures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors that East Norriton Township hereby approves this grant application and authorizes application to the DVRPC for TAP funding in the amount of \$600,000.00, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors that East Norriton Township commits to the expenditure of matching funds equivalent to all pre-construction activities, including engineering design, environmental clearances, right-of-way acquisition, utility relocation, as may be necessary for the project’s success.
