**EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF EAST NORRITON TOWNSHIP AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A NEW PARTIAL QUIET ZONE (10PM – 7AM) AT THE GERMANTOWN PIKE RAILROAD CROSSING IDENTIFIED BY THE FEDERAL RAILROAD ADMINISTRATION AS CROSSING NUMBER 589843J

WHEREAS, Railroad Crossing No. 589843J is located on Germantown Pike in East Norriton Township and used as a freight line; and

WHEREAS, a resident of East Norriton Township expressed concerns about the freight train sounding its horns during the evening hours when neighboring residents are sleeping; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors understands that quality of life is being impacted by the sound of the horns during the evening hours; and

WHEREAS, the Township has followed the guidelines established by the Federal Railroad Administration in creating a Quiet Zone and determined based on the Quiet Zone Calculator results that Railroad Crossing No. 589843J does qualify as a Quiet Zone.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the East Norriton Township Board of Supervisors authorizes establishing Railroad Crossing No. 589843J as a New Partial Quiet Zone between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M. and authorizes the Township Manager to proceed with the installation of the appropriate signage and notifying the appropriate agencies as outlined in the Federal Railroad Administration guidelines.


