NORRIS CITY AVENUE PUMP STATION**


BE IT RESOLVED, that East Norriton Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania hereby requests a PA Small Water and Sewer Program grant in the amount of \$464,880.00 from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development Commonwealth Financing Authority to be used for sanitary sewer pump station force main replacement at our Norris City Avenue Pump Station.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township does hereby designate Robert R. Hart, Township Manager as the official to execute all documents and agreements between East Norriton Township and the Commonwealth Financing Authority to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.


