

East Norriton Township – Regular Meeting
April 18, 2017

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township was called to order by the Vice Chairwoman, Angelina Salamone at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 18, 2017, at the Township Municipal Building. Supervisors present were Angelina Salamone, Marc Alfarano, Tina Howell, and Kevin McDevitt. Chairman Dennis DeSanto was absent.

After roll call, Vice Chairwoman Salamone asked for a moment of silence. The Pledge of Allegiance was then recited by all in attendance.

Vice Chairwoman Salamone announced that the Board of Supervisors met earlier this evening in Executive Session to discuss matters of litigation and personnel.

Vice Chairwoman Salamone announced the first item on the agenda, Merit/Unit Citation Presentation. Chief of Police, Kary Kates presented Sergeant Matthew Brannen with a Merit Citation and Police Officers Joe Carfrey and Andrew Kunkel with a Unit Citation for their exceptional performance in the line of duty to aid in the arrest and charging of a suspect with Invasion of Privacy, Loitering and Prowling at Night. Detective Anthony Caso, Officer Paul Ladson and Officer Samantha Smith were absent from the presentation for the Unit Citation.

Vice Chairwoman Salamone introduced the next item on the agenda, MCATO Presentation. Executive Director, Ronald Wagenmann gave a brief presentation on the Montgomery County Association of Township Officials.

Vice Chairwoman Salamone introduced the next item on the agenda, Approval of Meeting Minutes. Mr. McDevitt made a motion to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of March 28, 2017. The motion was seconded by Mr. Alfarano and approved unanimously.

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Vice Chairwoman Salamone introduced the next item on the agenda, Finance Reports for March 2017. Mrs. Howell made a motion to approve the Finance Reports. The motion was seconded by Mr. Alfarano and approved unanimously.

Vice Chairwoman Salamone introduced the next item on the agenda, Department Reports for March 2017. Mr. Alfarano made a motion to approve the Department Reports. The motion was seconded by Mr. McDevitt and approved unanimously.

Vice Chairwoman Salamone asked if there were any comments from the Board of Supervisors, there were none.

Vice Chairwoman Salamone then asked if there were any citizens to be heard, there were none.

Mr. McDevitt introduced the first item under “New Business”, Resolution No. 2718 – Proclamation – Norriton Fire Engine Co. 100th Anniversary. Mr. McDevitt read Resolution No. 2718 into the record. Mr. McDevitt made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2718. The motion was seconded by Mr. Alfarano and approved unanimously.

Mrs. Howell introduced the next item on the agenda, Resolution No. 2719 – Declaring Local Government Week. Mrs. Howell read Resolution No. 2719 into the record. Mrs. Howell made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2719. The motion was seconded by Mr. Alfarano and approved unanimously.

Mr. McDevitt introduced the next item on the agenda, Resolution No. 2720 – 325 and 327 East Johnson Highway Land Development Waiver Request. Code Enforcement/Zoning Director, Tiffany Loomis reviewed Resolution No. 2720 granting a waiver of land development for 325 through 327 East Johnson Highway, totaling four parcels, for a lot line adjustment creating two parcels. Mr. McDevitt made a motion to

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approve Resolution No. 2720. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Howell and approved unanimously.

Mrs. Howell introduced the next item on the agenda, Resolution No. 2721 – Authorizing Application for Traffic Signal Approval to PADOT – Germantown Pike and Trooper Road. Public Works Director, Doug Jones reviewed Resolution No. 2721 authorizing the application for traffic signal approval to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for the upgrade of the traffic signal at Germantown Pike and Trooper Road. Mrs. Howell made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2721. The motion was seconded by Mr. Alfarano and approved unanimously.

Mr. McDevitt introduced the next item on the agenda, Resolution No. 2722 – Authorizing Application for Traffic Signal Approval to PADOT – Township Line Road and North Wales Road. Public Works Director, Doug Jones reviewed Resolution No. 2722 authorizing the application for traffic signal approval to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for the upgrade of the traffic signal at Township Line Road and North Wales Road. Mr. Alfarano made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2722. The motion was seconded by Mr. McDevitt and approved unanimously.

Mrs. Howell introduced the next item on the agenda, Resolution No. 2723 – Authorizing the Disposal of Township Equipment and Files. Township Manager, Robert Hart reviewed Resolution No. 2723. Mr. Alfarano made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2723. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Howell and approved unanimously.

Vice Chairwoman Salamone read the Supervisors Schedule of Meetings from April 19, 2017 thru May 29, 2017.

Vice Chairwoman Salamone called on Township Manager, Robert Hart for Managers Update. Mr. Hart reviewed that the work on the Township's infrastructure continues; the evaluation of the Township sewer system is being performed and a report

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should be presented to the Board of Supervisors at the May or June regular meeting; the Easter Egg Hunt was well attended this year; and the Township is now accepting registrations for Summer Camp.

Vice Chairwoman Salamone asked if there was any Other Business. Township Solicitor, Sean Kilkenny reviewed a Stipulation and Order of Settlement for 2800 Potshop Lane. Mr. McDevitt made a motion to authorize the Township Solicitor to sign and settle the litigation. The motion was seconded by Mr. Alfarano and approved unanimously.

Vice Chairwoman Salamone asked if there were any residents who wished to speak, there were none.

Mrs. Howell made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:40 p.m.; the motion was seconded by Mr. Alfarano and approved unanimously.
