

East Norriton Township – Regular Meeting  
January 6, 2020

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Supervisors of East Norriton Township was called to order by Chairman McDevitt at 7:40 p.m. on Monday, January 6, 2020, at the Township Municipal Building. Supervisors present were Kevin McDevitt, Amanda Cappelletti, Dennis DeSanto, Ashley DiPiero, and Joseph Gavanus Jr.

After roll call, the Pledge of Allegiance was then recited by all in attendance.

Chairman McDevitt announced that the Board of Supervisors met earlier this evening in Executive Session to discuss matters of litigation and personnel and at the Reorganization meeting held earlier this evening.

Chairman McDevitt introduced the next item on the agenda, Approval of Meeting Minutes. Vice Chairwoman Cappelletti made a motion to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of December 10, 2019. The motion was seconded by Supervisor DiPiero and approved unanimously.

Chairman McDevitt asked if there were any citizens to be heard, there were none.

Chairman McDevitt asked if there were any comments from the Board of Supervisors, Vice Chairwoman Cappelletti commented on the wonderful holiday events that took place this past holiday season in East Norriton Township.

Vice Chairwoman Cappelletti introduced the first item on the agenda under “New Business”, Approval of Assessment Appeal Agreement – GH Real Holdings, Inc. Township Manager, Robert Hart reviewed this item. Chairman McDevitt made a motion to approve the Assessment Appeal Agreement. The motion was seconded by Supervisor DiPiero and approved unanimously.

Township Manager, Robert Hart reviewed Resolution No. 2803. Chairman McDevitt made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2803. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Gavanus.

Chairman McDevitt read the Supervisors Schedule of Meetings from January 7, 2020 through February 25, 2020.

Chairman McDevitt introduced the next item on the agenda, “Other Business”. There was none.

Chairman McDevitt called on Township Manager, Robert Hart for the Manager’s Update. Township Manager, Robert Hart stated “It’s going to be a busy 2020.”

Supervisor DeSanto addressed a social media rumor, Walmart is not for rent, it is for sale.

Chairman McDevitt asked if there were any residents who wished to speak; there were none.

Supervisor DeSanto congratulated Supervisor Gavanus.
