### 2.1.4 Body Armor/High Risk Incidents

- A. In addition to the mandatory requirement of the wearing of body armor while on duty, body armor shall be worn by all sworn officers when responding to a hostile or threatening environment such as, but not limited to:
1. Barricaded gunman incidents
  2. Hostage situations
  3. Felony in progress incidents
  4. Domestic involving weapons
  5. Search warrants (premises)
  6. Arrest warrants (not in custody)
  7. Any other type situation or incident whereby the Shift Supervisor, Lieutenant, or Chief of Police deems it appropriate.
