
2.5.4 Prisoner Escapes

- A. If a prisoner escapes while being transported, the following actions will immediately be taken by the transporting officer(s):
1. Persons to be notified:
 - a. The Duty Supervisor or OIC.
 - b. The Montgomery County Police Dispatcher.
 2. The Duty supervisor shall immediately make notification to the following:
 - a. The Chief of Police.
 - b. Officers in primary police jurisdiction.
 - c. Neighboring police jurisdictions.
 - d. If applicable, Victim(s) of the prisoner's criminal act(s).
 3. Reports to be prepared:
 - a. The transporting officer shall complete an Incident Report (escape from custody) detailing the events surrounding the escape.
 - b. The Duty Supervisor/OIC and any assisting officer(s) shall complete Supplemental Reports detailing the procedures followed.
 - c. A copy of the incident report and any other reports determined necessary will be forwarded to the Chief of Police and the Lieutenant.
 4. Other actions to be taken:
 - a. Notification to the police agency in the jurisdiction of the last known address of the escapee.
 - b. Notification to the police agency where the victim resides and or works, if known

(Facsimiles may be used).

- c. NCIC/CLEAN entry as soon as possible in regards to the escapee(s).
