**2.7.3 Service of Civil process**

- A. Generally, the East Norriton Twp. Police Department only serves traffic and criminal warrants. The Department will serve Protection from Abuse Orders when directed by the court. Under the guidelines of the Mental Health Act, officers apply for and serve 302 commitments, and will assist other agencies with the service of 302 Warrants. Officers shall log Emergency PFA's in the LEGAL PROCESS REPORT before attempting service.
- B. The East Norriton Twp. Police Department shall assist the members of the Montgomery County Sheriff's Department, the Pennsylvania State Constables, and MCES in the serving of civil process or other legal processes upon request.
