2.7.5 Execution of Criminal Process (Warrants)

- A. For general procedures on execution of warrants, officers shall follow the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure, Chapter 5, Rule 515; dealing with Procedures in Court Cases.
- B. In addition to the procedures outlined in these sections, officers shall also follow G.O. 1.2.4 dealing with arrests in summary violations.
- C. Served, Paid or Recalled Warrants:
 - 1. When a warrant has been served, paid or recalled by the District Justice the warrant shall be returned to the District Justice's Office and the warrant information removed from the LEGAL PROCESS RECORD and the East Norriton Police computer warrant list.
 - 2. The officer who served the warrant shall ensure that the person arrested has been removed from the NCIC and CLEAN systems.
- D. All officers shall, when executing any type of warrant, follow the policies and procedures outlined in G.O.1.3.1, dealing with the Use of Force and use only the amount of force necessary to affect the arrest.
- E. Officers who are going to serve a search warrant shall serve them in accordance with the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure, Rule 204; dealing with Search Warrants.
