Procedures for Visitors in Cell

3.1.23 Visitation

- A. Visitation of a detainee in a Cell is not permitted.
- B. Visitation is permitted in the temporary holding area, but will be limited to an Attorney for detainee, or parent/guardian of a juvenile. Detainee(s), if appropriate, shall be secured during the visit. “When the counsel for the defendant is present, the defendant must be permitted to communicate fully and confidentially with defense counsel immediately prior to and during the arraignment.” PaR.CrimP571(B). Counsel should be asked to show their PA Supreme Court ID or at least provide their ID number (to be recorded on the incident report).
- C. All visitors must present proof of identity and shall be informed that they and their property may be searched for weapons and contraband by an officer of the same sex, prior to entering the secured portion of the Police Station. If they refuse to consent, the visit shall not be allowed.
