3.1.4 Emergency Evacuation Plan

- A. Due to the nature and layout of the Police Building, there are two available exits from the facility in the event of a fire. Both exits are clearly marked with overhead EXIT signs.
- B. Police personnel are responsible for the removal of all person(s) or detainees within the holding facility. Officers shall escort person(s) from the holding facility to one of the exits listed on the floor plan which is posted.
- C. Detainees removed from the holding facility shall be placed into a secure police vehicle for transport to another location if needed. Detainees shall remain under constant supervision. Such other locations may include:
 - 1. The Montgomery County Correctional Facility
 - 2. The Norristown Police Department
 - 3. The Plymouth Police Department
 - 4. The Whitpain Police Department
- D. Any detainee who complains of injury as a result of an evacuation shall be taken to the nearest hospital by Ambulance. Such detainee shall be properly secured, accompanied by and under constant surveillance by an officer of this agency.
