3.1.7 Tools and Culinary Equipment

- A. At any time repairs are necessary to any part of the holding facility there shall be no detainees in the immediate area of such work. In the event the repair is necessary and a detainee is present, an officer shall be in the holding facility for the duration of the repair.
1. Employees or contract workers shall not enter the holding facility without first obtaining authorization from the Shift Supervisor or OIC.
 2. In order to prevent tools or other instruments from becoming lost, stolen or misplaced during work a security inspection of the holding facility shall be conducted by the Shift Supervisor or OIC prior to and after the repair work.
 3. This inspection will be of all occupied and unoccupied cells and interview areas.
 4. At no time is a detainee in a cell permitted to have in their possession any instrument, device or object for the purpose of eating, smoking, writing or the like.
 5. There is no smoking permitted in the Police Department building.
