### 3.2.4 Emergency Evacuation and Fire Prevention Plan

- A. As previously stated in General Order 3.1.4, there are two available exits from the Facility in the event of an emergency situation. Prisoner(s) shall be removed from the Temporary Holding Area to a place of safety outside the building.

An example of this would be to place the prisoner inside a patrol car away from the building. The prisoner will be supervised at all times. Depending on the circumstances, consideration should be given to transporting the prisoner to another police department for temporary holding.

- B. As previously stated in General Order 3.1.3, the Temporary Holding Facility has an overhead sprinkler system as well as wall mounted fire extinguishers.
- C. In order to prevent a fire, smoking is prohibited in the temporary holding area. No matches, lighters, or other fire initiating device shall be used in the temporary holding area.
