3.4.3 Release of Police Reports

- A. A request to view or receive copies of Accident Reports shall be limited to the following persons:
1. Any OWNER OF PROPERTY that was DAMAGED by a vehicle accident or other incident that was subject of the police or fire report,
 3. Any ATTORNEY, INSURANCE AGENT, or INVESTIGATOR who has been hired by or is acting as an agent, and provides proper identification or letterhead,
 5. Any other person named in a report may receive a copy of a report with the proper court order SUBPOENAED by a court of law,
 6. All persons are required to pay the prevailing fee before receiving a copy of any accident report. (*See General Order 2.4.6 D*)
- B. All other requests for police reports must be fulfilled under the requirements of the Pennsylvania Right to Know Act (RTK). See G.O. 4.1.12 and East Norriton Township Resolution N. 2076
